Discussion ensued following each.
- 5. The BOT team presented a first proposal designated as the Article 9 Appendix (BOT and UFF Exclusive Assignment Dispute Resolution [ADR] Grievance Procedure). The BOT team also presented counterproposals (4th proposals) designated as Article 1 (Recognition) and Article 2 (Consultation). Additionally, the BOT team presented a counterproposal (2nd proposal) designated as Article 3 (UFF Privileges). After caucus, the BOT team also presented counterproposals (2nd proposals) designated as Article 14 (Promotion Procedure) and Article 15 (Tenure). Discussion ensued following each.
- 6. The BOT and UFF teams reached tentative agreement on Article 26 (Payroll Deduction) and Article 30 (Amendment and Duration).
