## **ARTICLE 7** 1 MINUTES, REGULATIONS, BUDGETS, AND REPORTS 2 3 7.1 Policy. In accordance with Florida Statutes, Chapter 447.203(17)(d), the 4 University will provide the information listed in sections 7.2 and 7.3 to enable the 5 UFF to fulfill its role as collective bargaining representative. The UFF has a 6 7 corresponding responsibility to use the information in an accurate manner. 8 7.2 Board and University Documents. 9 (a) The University shall provide the UFF with hard copies of the BOT-UFF 10 agreement and all supplements to the Agreement, consistent with the provisions of 11 Article 28. 12 (b) The University shall make the following documents available by links on 13 the University web site: 14 (1) the minutes of the meetings of the Board of Trustees; 15 (2) University regulations published under the Administrative 16 Procedure Act; and 17 (3) the University's operating budget, summary by year. 18 (c) The University shall ensure that a copy of each of the following 19 documents is made available in the Orlando campus library: 20 (1) the minutes of the Board of Trustee's committee and 21 subcommittee meetings; 22 (2) the University's operating budget; 23 (3) the University's expenditure analysis for the previous year 24 (4) University regulations published under the Administrative 25 Procedure Act. 26 (d) Upon UFF request, the University shall make the following documents 27 available to the UFF, at no cost, no more than once per calendar yearsummer 28 session and semester: 29 (1) On or before October 1-and, -March 1 and August 1st, a report 30 reflecting employee salaries for the then-current academic yearsemester. This 31 report will include the following data elements in spreadsheet format: listing of 32 employees with name, salary administrative plan annual rate, job code, job code 33 title, college, department, UCC ID, date of hire, and complete work address. 34 (2) Worksheet reports, on or before October 1, and March 1, and 35 August 1st, where prepared, to reflect posted payroll changes. These worksheets 36 would include the following data elements in spreadsheet format: employee name, 37 job title, administrative title, liability department name, UCF ID, date of hire, prior 38 rate of pay, new rate of pay, percent increase, type of increase (e.g., equity, market, 39 merit, etc.), and FTE. 40

41	(3) A report showing fall faculty and administrative and professional
42	employment
43	for the then-current academic <del>yearsemester</del> , on or before <u>October 1 and</u> , March 1st
44	1, and August 1 of the summer session or that academic yearsemester (e.g., report
45	for fallSpring 2004-2020 would be available on or before March 1, 20052020).
46	This report will include the following data elements in spreadsheet format: name,
47	job code, employee class, home department number, liability department number,
48	budget entity (E&G, C&G, Auxiliary), primary campus assignment, FTE,
49	budgeted weeks, date of hire, highest degree earned, year of highest degree, faculty
50	rank, UCF ID, tenure status, tenure date, annual salary, termination date.
51	(4) On or before November 1st, one or more reports summarizing
52	faculty activity for the prior academic year (e.g., reports available by November 1,
53	20152020, would reflect loads for Summer 20142019, Fall 20192014, and Spring
54	20152020). These reports will include the following data elements in spreadsheet
55	format: reporting term, employee name, primary department, rank, UCF ID, tenure
56	status, activity code, FTE, and level of effort per activity code by employee.
57	(e) All documents and reports described in subsection (d) shall be provided in
58	electronic format.
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60	7.3 Request for information. Any request for information beyond the scope
61	contained herein in Section 7.1, shall be made in writing by the UFF to the
62	University. Where such information is readily available at the University level, the
63	University shall endeavor to provide such information at no or minimal cost.
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65	7.4 Bargaining Unit Member List. Upon request and not more than once per
66	semester, the University shall provide the UFF, at no cost, with an electronic list
67	including name, department/unit, position code, title/rank, e-mail address, contact
68	telephone number, work address, date of hire, college or unit, contact mailing
69	addresses for each employee in the bargaining unit.
