


Student/Faculty ratio at UCF, FSU, UF (Orlando Sentinel)

UCF student-to-faculty ratio high in state, nation

The number of students per faculty member at the University of Central Florida has exceeded fellow state universities for 20 years. It was about double the U.S. average for four-year public universities in 2022, the latest available national data.




How UCF stacks up statewide

The University of Central Florida had more students per faculty member than any other state university in 2024.
